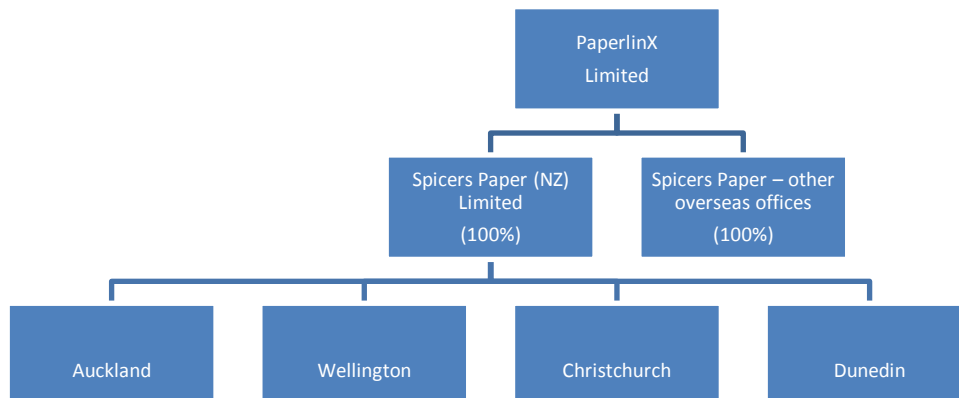

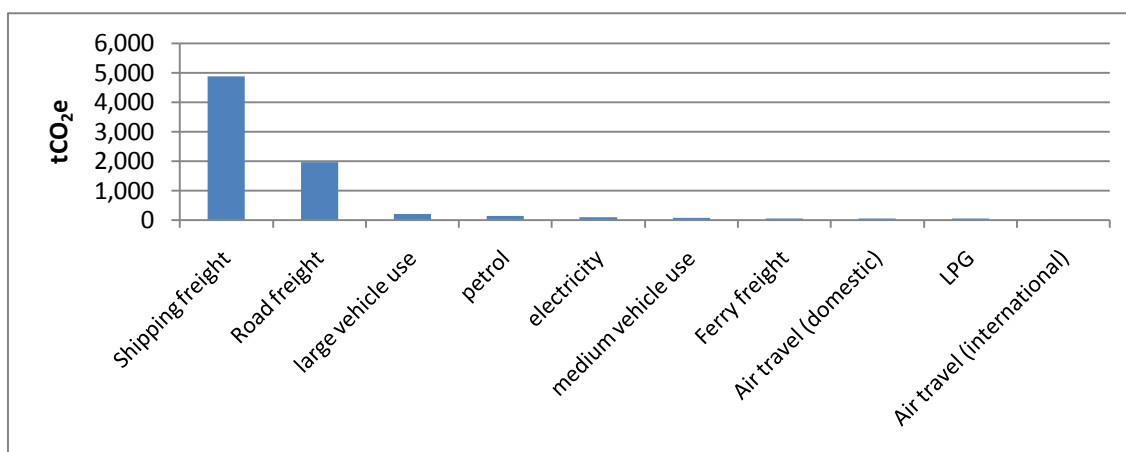


Consolidation approach – operational control

GHG emissions source inclusions – the diagram below shows the operational GHG emissions for Spicer's Paper by emissions source. Spicer's Paper's total emissions for this period were 7,526.44 tonnes carbon dioxide equivalents (tCO₂e) comprising 258.28 tCO₂e Scope 1, 141.55 tCO₂e Scope 2 and 7126.62 tCO₂e Scope 3 emissions.



GHG emissions source exclusions –

- R22 refrigerant use in Wellington offices – data was not available for this measurement period
- Taxi use – data was not available for this measurement period

GHG emissions reduction commitments – Spicer's Paper has developed a GHG emissions reduction plan. Some projects in this plan include:

- to increase waste recycling by providing staff with recycle bins and monitor waste
- to reduce fuel use through a staff information campaign
- to reduce electricity consumption through identifying opportunities and engage external contractors to provide guidance around reductions
