- Laboratory
- Digital intermediates (scanning, grading and digital intermediate)
- Client services

Park Road is committed to responsible energy management and improving its environmental impact. The organisation is committed to managing and reducing its greenhouse gas footprint.

Park Road was awarded with the 'Greening the Screen Award' in 2007 at the Women in film and Televisions (WIFT) Awards. The Award acknowledges Park Road's commitment to sustainability and responsible energy management. Park Road has made responsible energy management part of their day-to-day business with energy efficiency objectives taken into account wherever possible.

Measurement period – 01/04/2009 to 31/03/2010

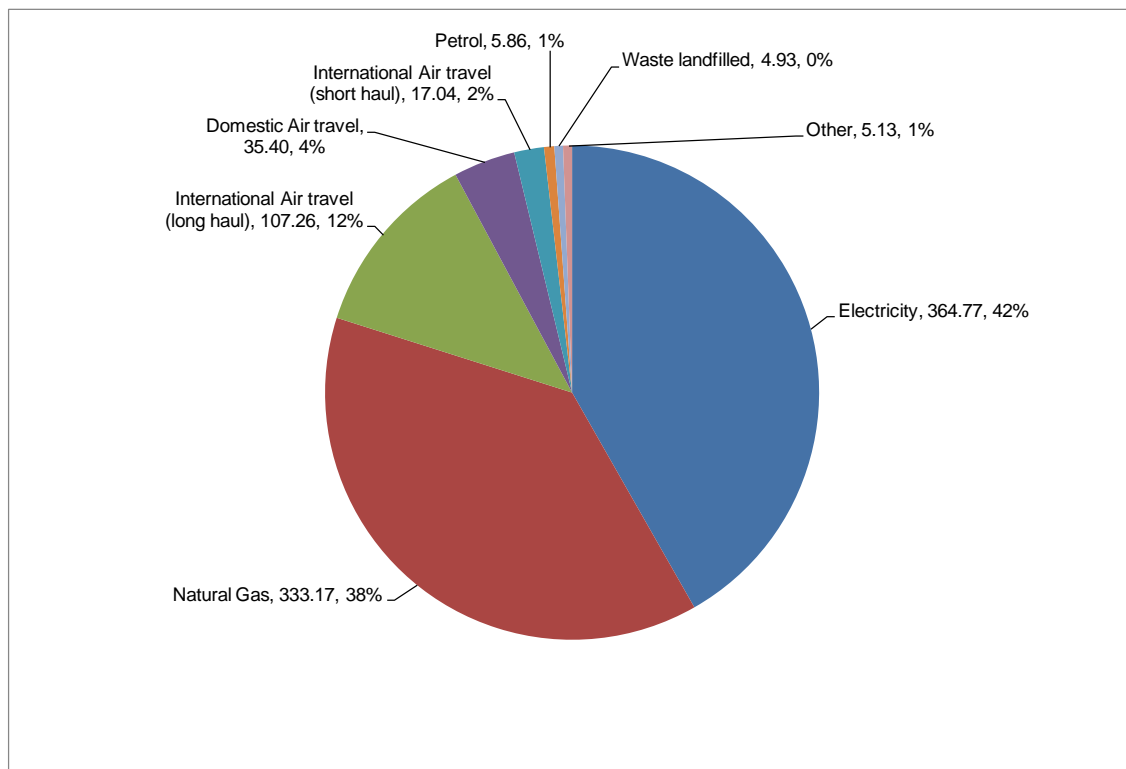
GHG emissions source inclusions – the diagram below shows the operational GHG emissions for Park Road by emissions source. Park Road's total emissions for

the period 01 April 2009 to 31 March 2010 were 873.56 tonnes carbon dioxide equivalents (CO₂e), all of which were operational emissions and which comprised 341.45 tonnes CO₂e Scope 1, 364.7 tonnes CO₂e Scope 2 and 167.34 tonnes CO₂e Scope 3 emissions.



GHG emissions source exclusions – the following emissions sources were identified and excluded from the inventory:

- Freight (road, air) – estimated emissions are less than the *de minimis* of 1%
- Cardboard, LDPE plastics – estimated emissions are less than the *de minimis* of 1%

GHG emissions reduction commitments – Park Road has developed a GHG emissions reduction plan that builds on measures already in place at Park Road. Some of the new initiatives in this plan include:

- reduce GHG Emissions from electricity and natural gas by reconfiguring air conditioning
- reduce GHG emissions from waste to landfill by the use of composting initiatives
- reduce GHG Emissions from air travel, accommodation and rental cars by monitoring and managing travel-related expenditure
