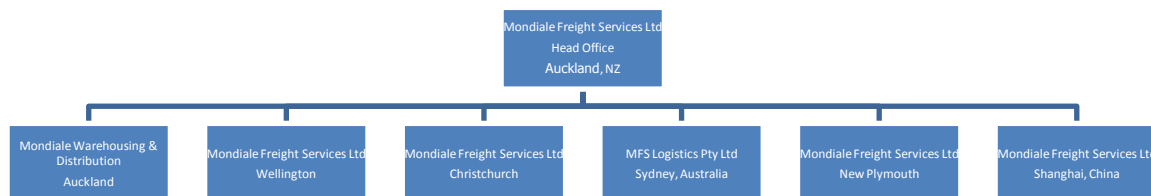

1495.36 tonnes CO₂e Scope 1 emissions

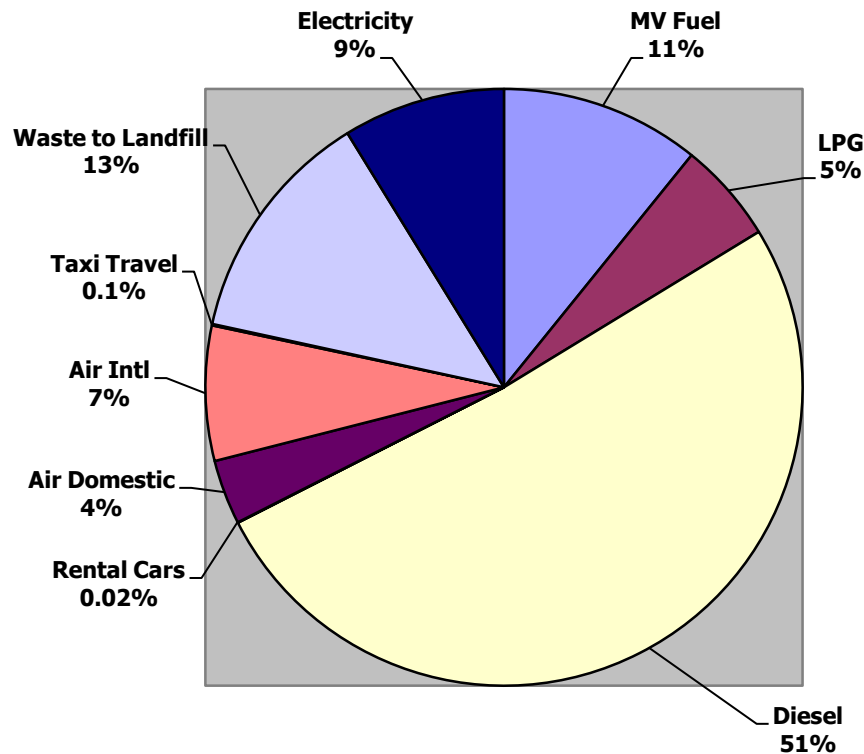
199.33 tonnes CO₂e Scope 2 emissions

Emissions source exclusions – Rental car use, electricity and waste for Sydney office, as well as electricity and waste for the Taranaki office was excluded as it was proven to be de minimis. The HFC leakage was excluded as information around top up was not available.

Emissions reduction commitments – Mondiale has developed a GHG emissions reduction plan. Some projects in this plan include:

- Reduce electricity emissions by 5% per employee
- Reduce fuel emissions by 5% per employee
- Reduce waste emissions by 5% per employee
- Reduce air travel emissions by 5% per employee

Threshold of materiality – Excluded emissions do not exceed 5% of the total footprint for organisation stated.
